

## Competition overview

<b>Title</b>	<b>Two-phase open international competition for the creation of a work of art at the new "eins" administrative building in Chemnitz</b>
<b>Competition languages</b>	German and English
<b>Budget</b>	€200,000/net for creation of the winning design
20 December 2021 until 13 March 2022	<b>Application procedure (Phase 1)</b>  National and international visual artists are invited to apply to participate in the competition.  - Evidence is required of two permanently installed works of art on buildings or of works of art in the public domain (national and/or international) that have been created in the past based on the artist's own design.  - 10 artists will be selected to participate in Phase 2.  In addition, the representatives of the specialist prize jury will propose a further 10 artists to participate directly in Phase 2.
1 May 2022 until 31 July 2022	<b>Competition (Phase 2)</b>  20 selected participants submit a design for a permanently installed work of art; in total, six locations on or in front of the building are available for selection.  The artists may choose the genre and form of art at their own discretion. An ensemble is also possible (as an alternative to a single location).  Participation allowance: €3,000/net
28 / 29 September 2022	<b>Decision on the winning design</b>  Prize money: 1 <sup>st</sup> prize: €8,000/net 2 <sup>nd</sup> prize: €6.000/net 3 <sup>rd</sup> prize: €4,000/net
